

Directions to Print Site Parameter Values & Graphs

Go to <https://www.ccpasec.org>

Click on **Menu link 'Data'** across top of page.

A list of sites under 'Chemical/Physical Data' and 'Biosurvey Data' will be displayed.

Scroll to and **click on the site name** whose data you want to look at.
(Example Lick Run)

A new browser tab should open with the data sheet for this site.

At the bottom of the page the **tab on the left side** is highlighted and labelled '**Physical-Chemical Data Sheet**'.

There are **tabs to the right** of this tab to view individual parameters such as **pH, Cond (conductivity), DO**, etc. **Click on the parameter tab** you wish to view. (Example: 'pH')

The pH tab will open and show a list of monitoring dates and the corresponding pH values recorded for those dates as well as a graph of the pH values.

To print the graph and list of monitoring dates and pH values,

- click on the **Printer icon** at the top left of the screen under the green rectangle **or hold down the 'ctrl' key and press the 'p' key** at the same time.
 - A '**Print setting' pop-up window** will display the first print page with settings you may change.
 - When you have selected the settings you want, click the '**NEXT' button**.
 - Depending on the browser you use, this will allow you to print the file from there or produce a PDF file which can be looked at in Adobe Reader or saved to your computer. You may then print it from the Adobe Reader program.
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In the **Chrome Browser**, you may **directly print the page from there** without saving the file **or you may save the file as a PDF file** which can be opened later in the Adobe Reader program.

In the **Edge Browser**, a **small rectangular box at the bottom of the screen** will appear with the question **“What do you want to do with THE_SITE_NAME – pH.pdf?”** Your button choices are **‘Open’, ‘Save’/‘Save as’, and ‘Cancel’**.

To **‘Open’ the file**, click the **‘Open’ button**. It will open in your Adobe Reader program. From there you may print it out.

To **‘Save’ the file**, click the **‘Save’ button** and it will be saved in the usual place you save downloaded files.

To **‘Save as’ the file**, click **‘Save as’** and you will have to choose where to save it.

Once saved, it may be opened anytime and printed out in the Adobe Reader program.

Directions to Print Site Parameter Graphs

Go to <https://www.ccpasec.org>

Click on **Menu link ‘Sites’** across top of page.

Click on **‘Non-Marcellus Sites’ link** on left side menu of page or click on **‘Marcellus Sites’ link** on left side menu of page to find a list with the desired sites.

A list of Sites (Non- Marcellus or Marcellus Sites) will be visible in the left menu.

Click on the **site name** you want to see (Example: **_Lick Run**). The site page will be visible.

Scroll down to the place under the small map of the site location to the link:

Chemical & Biosurvey Data Graphs . Click on the link and the parameter graphs will be visible. Scroll down through the graphs to view each one.

To **print the graphs**, hold down the **'ctrl' key** and **press the 'p' key at the same time**. This should bring up a smaller **Printer window** from which you may print the whole web page (consisting of many print pages) or any of the print pages you want. (Example: Custom Page Range: 5-12).

Select **'Print'** when you have chosen the print options you want and your printer is ready.

A printout of the selected pages should result.
